

For the record, I'll note that the 1840 U.S. Census included a William Wasson and his family of four living in East Oswego, Oswego County, New York. Because John and Jane Lambie Wasson lived in Amboy Township, Oswego County, New York at that time, some researchers suggest that this William Wasson was their son William, making him John (Jemima) Wasson's brother William. This is also incorrect. Not only is the age and gender makeup of that family incorrect, John and Jane's son William and his family were still living in Liverpool, England in 1841.
